- To develop independence of their own by managing apart from parents/guardians
- To encourage basic recognition of letters and numbers through play in preparation for school.

We strive to create a welcoming atmosphere with approachable staff to help create effective communication between parents and practitioners. When parents and practitioners work together, the results have a positive impact on the child's development and learning.

Ballygawley Early Years Playgroup is operational during term time from Monday to Friday. Currently we offer two part-time sessions;

- · Morning session, from 09.00 to 11.30.
- Afternoon session, from 12.30 to 15.00.

Our playgroup is currently allocated 48 funded places under the Pre-School Education Programme. We currently employ 3 qualified child care workers, who follow the CCEA Curricular Guidance for Pre-school Education.
